



Guidelines for Blankets

- Pastel or bright “baby” colors and prints are preferred
- Knitted or crocheted items should be made from yarn that is machine washable (usually acrylic)
- Knitted and crocheted blankets need to be tightly woven so babies cannot get their fingers or toes caught
- A low-loft (thin) batting is recommended to allow quilts to be more compact when folded to top a finished bag

Blanket sizes are suggested since handmade items must all be placed in a large bag along with donated clothing in order to be distributed to babies in need.

- Quilts & crib blankets: No larger than 45” X 30”
- Stroller/car seat blankets: 34” X 30”
- Fleece (floor) blankets: 44” X 44” (not including ties)

Guidelines for Other Items

- Please, no ties on bibs. Closure should be snaps or Velcro only.
- Toys should be free of buttons or plastic eyes, as these can be a choking hazard.
