



# How to Make a Sock Doll



Use new or clean, gently used socks and leftover fleece scraps to make this cute and useful doll. When disassembled, this cheerful bag decoration provides the new Mom with two pairs of socks and a washcloth.

## Step-by-Step Instructions

### You Will Need

- 1 pair white 18-36 month low-cut socks
- 1 pair colorful 0-6 month ankle socks
- 9 inch by 9 inch fleece fabric
- Toilet paper roll
- Fine point Sharpie marker
- 16 inches of 3.2mm ribbon
- Small cardstock tag saying: 2 pairs of socks and a washcloth
- Tapestry needle

Important: No pins, rubber bands, buttons or googly eyes.

Insert one white sock smoothly into the other and stretch over toilet paper roll, forming the body.

Fit one ankle sock into the toe of the other and roll back the ankle, forming the hat band.

Turn the sock-covered roll so the sock back is facing forward.

Stretch the hat onto the top, so the toe is facing forward. Make sure the band is down onto the cardboard. The heel will be at the back.

Lay fleece on a flat surface in a square position. Place roll onto fleece so that one inch of white sock shows above fleece. Fold the left side of the fleece across the roll, then the right. Fold all layers securely up into the roll.

Use the Sharpie marker to add eyes, tiny lashes and a mouth.

Thread ribbon through the back of the hat, entering at the back right and exiting at the back left (about a 1 inch gap keeps the doll facing forward when tied onto the bag).

Thread the tag onto the ribbon and knot.
